

Relations to the pharmaceutical industry

Hans Bisgaard (HB) does not receive royalties for patents, and has no shares in asthma-related pharmaceutical companies.

HB's professorship at the University of Copenhagen was established in 1998 by Region Hovedstaden partly based on a one-time donation from the three pharmaceutical companies AstraZeneca, GlaxoSmithKline and Merck (main producers of asthma medicine).

The funding for HB's research comes from public and private funds with no current funding from asthma-related pharmaceutical companies.

HB has within the last three years received honorarium for presentations abroad and consulting tasks from the pharmaceutical companies AstraZeneca, Merck and Chiesi.
